

EXACYL film-coated tablets:

- Box of 20 tablets each containing 250 mg.

- Box of 20 tablets each containing 500 mg.

EXACYL oral solution :

- Box of 5 ampules of 10 ml each containing 1 g.

## INDICATIONS:

This drug is an ANTIHAEMORRHAGICAL agent recommended for bleedings.

## **CONTRAINDICATIONS:**

This drug is contraindicated in patients with:

- Thombosis,
- Severe renal insufficiency.

In case of doubt, consult your doctor or pharmacist.

## **PRECAUTIONS:**

Inform your doctor in the event of pregnancy or breast-feeding. NEVER LEAVE THE DRUG WITHIN THE REACH OF CHILDREN.

# OTHER POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS OF THIS DRUG:

As with any active product, this drug can, in some individuals, produce more or less troublesome side effects: nausea, vomiting, vertigo, etc.

# DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:

ORAL ROUTE

EXACYL film-coated tablets:

- Adults : 2 to 4 g per 24 hours in 2 or 3 divided doses.

- Children : 20 mg/kg per day on average.

EXACYL oral solution:

- Adults : 2 to 4 ampules per 24 hours, divided in several doses.

- Children : follow strictly your doctor's prescription.

IN ALL CASES FOLLOW STRICTLY YOUR DOCTOR'S PRESCRIPTION.
