Using Hairgaine 5 with other medicines
Please inform your doccor or pharmacist if you are ta
have recently taken any other medicines, including
medicines obtained without a prescription.

The dose for each application is 1 mL of solution (corresponding to 30 drops), regardless of the size of the area to be treated. Spread the product from the centre out to the edge of the scalp with your kingers.

The maximum recommended dose is 2 ml and shot exceeded with the possibility of systemic effects.

If you forget to use Hairgaine 5 In case you have forgotten to apply the solution in the scheduled hour apply it as soon as you remember and aftr continue as determined before. Do not apply a double do: to make up for a missing dose.

4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS
Like all medicines, Hairgaine 5 can cause side effethese are not experienced by all the users.

Frequent (≥ 1/100, < 1/10):
The most common adverse reactions are minor dermatological reactions which do not interfere with the treatment continuation but must be reported to your doc (consult a dermatologist).

n:-Palpitation, chest pain, tachycardia; -Electrocardiogram alteration (ECG); -Cardiac frequency increase; - Heart rate increase.

Note: has not been established a causal relation bet he cardiovascular effects and minoxidil topical use).

Rare (≥ 1/10000, < 1/1000): Skin – scalp: - Allergic contact dermatitis; - Baldness, capillary alterations;

- Urinary infections, r calculus; - Sexual dysfunction.

Eyes: - Visual disturbance (visual acuacy decrease);
- Conjunctivitis.

(Note: has not been stablished a causal relation between the effects in the eyes or in the nervous, reproductive and urinary systems and minoxidil topical use). Signs and symptoms of systemic absorption: chest pain (angina), irregular and accelerated heart rate, hypotensic
