

Otisedol

Ear Drops

An anesthetic-, antibiotic- and anhydrous propylene glycol Compound

Formula per 10 ml

Phenol

200 mg

Tetracaine HCI

100 mg

Chloramphenicol 100 mg Propylene glycol ad 10 ml

Otisedal is indicated in the treatment of acute inflammation of the middle ear (mastoditis) and outer auditory meatus.

Otisedal should be applied lukewarm and only if it is assured that the tympanic membrane is intact.

Indications

Otisedol acts alleviative and bactericidal. The lukewarm solution should be dropped into the affected ear with patient's head inclined to the side, the affected ear pointing upwards. After a few minutes the ear should be closed up with a pad of cotton wool. Simultaneous treatment by warm moist compress or dry heat (raytreatment) should be made only according to physician's advise.

Use

Otisedol may be applied 3-4 times during the day.

Presentation

One bottle of 10 ml per box.

Storage

Store below 20 °C.

Keep out of reach of children.
