Vitamin C

Properties

Prophylaxis and therapy of vitamin C deficiency. Activates the intermediary metabolism and cell respiration. Stimulating and tonifying actions.

Major indications

Scurvy. Poor general condition. Defective wound healing. Hemorrhagic diathesis (e.g. gingivitis). Reduced resistance to infections. Spring tiredness. Pregnancy. Lactation.

Dosage

Prophylaxis: 5–15 drops or 1 tablet 200 mg daily. Oral therapy: 20–40 drops, or 1 or more tablets 200 or 500 mg, or 1 effervescent tablet 1 g daily.

Intensive therapy of severe cases (frank scurvy, vitamin C saturation in acute infections, e.g. influenza, pneumonia, wounds, burns, fractures and deep corneal ulcers): 1–2 effervescent tablets daily.

Injection therapy: mild cases, 100–200 mg s.c., i.m. or i.v. daily; severe cases, 1–2 ampoules 500 mg i.m. or i.v. or 1 ampoule 1 g or more i.v. once weekly to once daily.

Instructions for use drop-counter

The built-in dropper enables an exact dose to be measured easily: The bottle should be held *vertically* upside-down. If drops do not flow immediately, the bottle should be shaken or tapped gently.

Chewable tablets 200 mg contain 0.5 g of sugar and effervescent tablets 1.6 g. The drops are free of sugar.
