Composition

Benzalkonium chloride 0.01% Cetrimide 0.2% in a water miscible base.

Indications

Treats and prevents nappy rash. Provides soothing relief for minor burns and wounds.

Nappy rash

Babies having sensitive skin need extra care. The nappy area is particularly prone to rashes and even the best kept babies get Nappy Rashes and sore bottoms from time to time.

Nappy Rash is due to irritation of the skin by the chemical breakdown of urine through urine-splitting germs.

In cases of accidental ingestion, symptomatic treatment is appropriate.
