Consult your dentist if no improvement is noticed after a few days. Gum irritation caused by dentures could mean that they need adjustment, in which case treatment with PANSORAL should be seen as a temporary solution only. NOTE: THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS 39 g OF ALCOHOL AT 96% PER 100 g.

Dosage and directions for use: This medication is for adult use only. Strictly for local application only. For application to the gums. Thoroughly clean and dry dentures before application. On average 1 to 4 applications (a nut-sized amount) per day. For permanent dentures: put a pea-sized amount onto the affected area, usually at incisor or molar level.

For temporary dentures: put the gel onto the part of the denture in contact with the affected area.

Once inside the mouth, the warmth and movements when chewing ensure that the gel spreads uniformly.

Undesirable effects: LIKE ANY ACTIVE PRODUCT, THIS MEDICATION CAN HAVE SIDE EFFECTS OF VARYING SEVERITY IN CERTAIN PATIENTS:

- hypersensitivity reactions to medical products containing salicylates.
