

## NAME OF THE MEDICINAL PRODUCT: INONGAN, Cream

### QUALITATIVE AND QUANTITATIVE COMPOSITION:

METHYL SALICYLATE: 12.50 g RACEMIC CAMPHOR: 1.00 g

for 100 g of cream

# **EXCIPIENTS:**

Sedefos 75® (ethylene distearate and diethylene glycol associated with polyoxyethylene fatty alcohol phosphate). Labrafil M2130® (saturated polyglycosylated glycerides), liquid paraffin, racemic menthol, eucalyptus oil, purified water.

# PHARMACEUTICAL FORM: Cream, tube of 55 g. PHARMACOTHERAPEUTIC CLASS:

analgesic (M: musculoskeletal system)

## WHAT THIS MEDICINE IS USED FOR

Local symptomatic treatment of muscle, tendon and ligament pain in adults.

### ATTENTION!

WHEN MUST THIS MEDICINE NOT BE USED

This medicine MUST NOT BE USED in the following cases:

- Allergy to salicylates or related drugs (non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs, aspirin) or to any of the ingredients.
- Do not apply on mucous membranes, in the eyes, on broken skin, on a moist or infected lesion, or under an occlusive bandage.

IF YOU ARE IN ANY DOUBT, YOU MUST CONSULT YOUR DOCTOR OR YOUR PHARMACIST FOR ADVICE.

## **SPECIAL WARNINGS:**

This medicine contains camphor and menthol (terpene derivatives) which, at excessive doses, may cause convulsions in infants and children. Follow the recommendations for use:

- Never apply more than the recommended dose (see Dosage section).
- Do not apply over a large area of the body.
- Follow the recommended frequency and duration of treatment.

## PRECAUTIONS FOR USE:

- This medicine is restricted to adults.
- In case of previous or recent epilepsy, A\$K YOUR DOCTOR FOR ADVICE.
- Wash your hands after use to avoid accidental contact with eyes and mucous membranes.

## HOW TO USE THIS MEDICINE

DOSAGE: RESTRICTED TO ADULTS

Local massage on the painful area, one or more times a day. Wash your hands after use.

METHOD AND ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION: Cutaneous route.

**DURATION OF TREATMENT:** Do not use for prolonged periods without medical advice.

#### POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS:

Like all medicines, this medicinal product may cause more or less bothersome effects in some people:

- possible local allergic reactions requiring discontinuation of the treatment
- possible normal redness of the skin at the site of application
- if the recommended doses are not followed, possible agitation and confusion in the elderly (due to the presence of camphor and menthol).

DO NOT HESITATE TO ASK YOUR DOCTOR OR PHARMACIST FOR ADVICE AND TO TELL YOUR DOCTOR OR PHARMACIST IF YOU NOTICE ANY SIDE EFFECTS NOT LISTED IN THIS LEAFLET
