

Topidic®

(Fusidic acid)

Properties

Topidic is an antibiotic with powerful antibacterial activity against a number of gram-positive organisms. Staphylococci, including the strains resistant to penicillin or to other antibiotics, are particularly susceptible to **Topidic**®.

Besides pronounced antibacterial activity against the majority of organisms responsible for skin infections, **Topidic** also possesses unique ability for penetration to the focus of infection, even when applied to intact skin.

Indications

Topidic® is indicated for treatment of skin infections caused by staphylococci, Streptococci, Propionibacterium acnes, Corynebacterium minutissimum, and other organisms sensitive to fusidic acid. The important indications being:

- Impetigo
- Boils
- Carbuncles
- Paronychia
- Infected wounds
- Sycosis barbae
- Hidradenitis
- Erythrasma

Side-Effects

Topidic® is remarkably well tolerated, and there is an extremely low frequency of hypersensitivity reactions.
