

Dexa-sine

Eye Drops

Instructions for Use

Composition - 2 -

1 ml contains: 1 mg (= 0.1%) dexamethasone phosphate in a sterile isotonic, preserved PVP-solution.

Indications - 4 -

All corticosteroid responsive inflammations of the eye, aseptic inflammations and irritations of the anterior segment of the eye, acute and chronic uveitis, iridocyclitis, episcleritis, non-infectious conjunctivitis, allergic, catarrhal and vernal conjunctivitis, injuries from chemical and thermal burns, keratitis rosacea.

Side effects, - 5 -

Secondary Manifestations

In some cases treatment with corticosteroids can produce a glaucoma. But clinical experiences have shown that with DEXA-SINE this possibility is nearly excluded.

Intolerance and Risks - 6 -

Latent glaucoma, certain viral diseases, tuberculosis, mycosis and loss of corneal substances. In bacterial inflammatory processes DEXA-SINE should only be used under adequate protection with antibiotics.

Dosage and Administration - 7 -

Unless directed otherwise by the physician, instill 1-2 drops 4-6 times daily into the conjunctival sac of the affected eye, in severe acute inflammations 1 drop every hour. Prolonged treatment over several days should only be carried out under medical supervision.

Medicines should be kept out of reach of children!

DEXA-SINE is a highly effective dexamethasone preparation. It possesses a particularly potent antiphlogistic and antiallergic action. Prolonged and very intensive contact of the corticosteroid with the eye is guaranteed. The vehicle solution is adjusted to the pH and the isotonicity of the lacrimal fluid and therefore is excellently tolerated.
