



Preservative free lubricant ophthalmic solution
sodium hyaluronate 0.4%
10 or 20 re-closable vials of 0.5 ml

Composition

Sodium hyaluronate 0.4%, dibasic sodium phosphate; monobasic sodium phosphate; sodium chloride; water for injection.

How is presented?

HYE is a preservative-free ophthalmic solution.
The pack contains 10 or 20 re-closable vials of 0.5 ml.

What is it?

HYE is a sterile, preservative free 0.4% ophthalmic solution of sodium hyaluronate, obtained by biotechnological synthesis. Sodium hyaluronate has muco-mimetic, muco-adhesive and viscoelastic properties that improve the tear film stability and keeps the ocular surface lubricated, moisturized and protected.

When should it be used?

The lubricant, moisturising and protective qualities of sodium hyaluronate relieve irritation, dry, burning and foreign body sensations in the eyes due to environmental elements such as wind, sun, dry air, salt water, smoke, excessive light, air conditioning, heating, prolonged use of computer or ocular surgery, conjunctivitis, contact lens use.

As far as the product is preservative free it is particularly suitable for sensitive eyes, for frequent and prolonged use and before and during contact lens wear.

How much to use?

1 drop in the eye 2-3 times daily.

Precautions and warnings

- do not use if the container is damaged
- do not use if you are sensitive to any of the components
- do not use after the expiry date shown on the container
- do not touch the eye with the tip of the container
- after administration, in rare cases, a slight temporary blurring of vision may be observed due to the viscosity of the solution. It is therefore advisable to wait for a few seconds before any activity that requires clear vision.
- leave at least 10-15 minutes between administration of any other ophthalmic drugs
- once opened each vial can be used for up to 12 hours
- keep out of the reach and sight of children
- the product is for external ophthalmic use only
- store below 25 °C
