# Mephigastryl

#### Composition

Each capsule contains:
Prochlorperazine dimaleate 10 mg
Meprobamate 100 mg
Magnesium oxide 100 mg
Belladonna powder 5 mg

#### **Properties**

Mephigastryl is a preparation intended for the management of various gastro-intestinal disorders. It possesses spasmolytic, anticholinergic, tranquillizing, and antacid action.

Prochlorperazine, a phenothiazine derivative, possesses powerful anti-emetic properties, used for the prevention and treatment of nausea and vomiting particularly when they are of central origin. It has also antihistaminic action. Meprobamate is a tranquillizer which relieves nervous tension and anxiety. It has also slight muscle relaxing properties. Magnesium oxide is a valuable antacid and a mild laxative. In Mephigastryl, magnesium oxide buffers hyperacidity of the stomach. Belladonna, an antispasmodic and anti-cholinergic drug, checks spasms of smooth muscles of the abdomen and reduces gastric hypersecretion.

#### Irritable and spastic colon, peptic, gastric and duodenal ulcers. Functional and organic spastic disorders associated with anxiety and emotional tension. Conditions associated

with hyperexcitability, hypermobility and

spasm of the G.I. and biliary tract, nervous indigestion and dyspepsia, bloating and flatulence, nausea and vomiting, gastritis, cholecystitis and pylorospasm, spastic constipation, and diverticulosis.

ponents potentiate each other, it has been possible to reduce their respective dosage to a minimum, thus avoiding any risks of toxic reactions without interfering with the effectiveness of the preparation. However, in very rare cases, some patients have experienced drowsiness.

#### Note The re

The recommended dosage should not be exceeded.

Mephigastryl, if given particularly in high dosage, may adversely affect the patient's reaction, e.g. as a road-user.

Like any other drug, it is advisable not to use

this preparation during the first three months of pregnancy.
