Brand of Miconazole Nitrate, USP
Antifungal

DESCRIPTION:

MICONAZ[®], brand of miconazole nitrate, formulated into a tincture or a gel intended for topical use against susceptible fungi.

PROPERTIES:

MICONAZ[®], is an imidazole antifungal agent which interferes with ergosterol synthesis and therefore alters the permeability of the cell membrane of sensitive fungi. It is active against a wide range of pathogenic fungi including yeasts, dermatophytes and gram-positive bacteria.

PHARMACOKINETICS:

Application of miconazole nitrate 2% (suspension oil / water) on the skin produces low serum concentrations below 0.01 µg/ml.

INDICATIONS:

MICONAZ[®] is indicated in the treatment of fungal infections of the skin in tinea pedis (athlete's foot), tinea corporis, tinea cruris, cutaneous candidiasis and tinea versicolor.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

Hypersensitivity to miconazole nitrate.

PRECAUTIONS:

Should a reaction suggesting chemical irritation or sensitivity develop, discontinue use immediately. Avoid contact with eyes.

ADVERSE REACTIONS:

Skin rash, burning, redness and allergic contact dermatitis have occasionally been reported.

DOSAGE & ADMINISTRATION:
