

Formula:	
Chlorhexidine (DCI) digluconate	0,10 g
Chlorobutanol (DCI)	0,10 g
Sodium Docusate (DCI)	0,10 g
Chloroform	0,5 ml
Excipient q.s	100 ml
(alcohol at 95°, glycerin, menthol, mint spirit, methyl p	arahydroxybenzoate,

Therapeutic Class: Local Antiseptic, Local Anesthetic (A: Digestive tract and metabolism).

Indications: • Tonsillitis • Pre and post-operative care in ENT and stomatology • Gingivitis, stomatitis, mouth ulcer, parodontitis.

Contraindication: Do not use in infants.

Precautions: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Eludril contains alcohol. Take care medication is not swallowed when administered to children.

Medical interactions: To avoid medical interactions, other treatments have to be indicated to the physician or pharmacist.

Dosage: Gargle or use as mouthwash 2 to 3 times daily or more depending on your physician's advice. Mean dosage = 15 ml of Eludril to dilute with water.

Administration: Dilute 2-4 coffee spoonfuls of Eludril solution in half a glass of water.

Side effects: Embarrassing effects have to be indicated to the physician.

Duration of stability: Do not exceed the use by date stated on the packaging. * Store 15° - 25° C away from light & humidity.
