

# Pronerv<sup>®</sup> capsules

antineuralgic

## Composition:

1 capsule contains:	
thiamine nitrate (vitamin B1)	100 mg
pyridoxine hydrochloride (vitamin B6)	200 mg
cyanocobalamin (vitamin B12)	0.5 mg

## Characteristics:

Pronerv contains a combination of important B vitamins. As coenzymes of numerous interlinked processes of intermediary metabolism, these are especially important for the maintenance of normal nerve functions.

Their combined administration in large doses is regarded as more effective than the individual components - especially to rapidly remedy existing deficiencies.

Vitamin B12 in a pharmacodynamically effective dose also has an analgesic effect.

## Indications:

For adjuvant therapy in:

polyneuropathies of various etiologies, especially endo- or exo-toxic, neuritides and neuralgias, radiculoneuritis due to degenerative spinal diseases, cervical syndrome, shoulder-arm syndrome, lumbar syndrome; sciatica, trigeminal neuralgia, intercostal neuralgia.

## Administration:

The capsules should be taken unchewed.

## Dosage:

In general, one capsule three times daily after meals.

## Contraindications:

Known hypersensitivity to an ingredient.

## Pregnancy and Lactation:

The tolerance of high doses of vitamin B6 during pregnancy is not fully established. Data on the potential accumulation of vitamins in breast milk beyond physiologic levels are not available.

## Side-Effects:

Hypersensitivity reaction with predominantly cutaneous manifestations have been observed - very rarely - after administration of B1, B12, but also B6.

Isolated cases of nervous lesions, such as sensory neuropathy with loss of reflexes, ataxia, disturbances of superficial and deep sensory function, have been reported after chronic intake of extremely high doses of vitamin B6.

## Interactions:

If L-dopa is administered at the same time, vitamin B6 can reduce its effect.

If colchicine, PAS, neomycin, or antidiabetic drugs of the biguanide type are used concurrently, the absorption of B12 is inhibited.

## Cautionary Advice:

The clinical picture and laboratory findings of a funicular myelosis and/or pernicious anemia can be masked by

preparations containing B12. This possibility should be considered before beginning treatment.

## Information for the Patient:

Unless prescribed otherwise, maintain the dose exactly.

If previous administration of vitamin-containing preparations has caused allergic symptoms, this must be reported to the physician before treatment.

In very rare cases, hypersensitivity symptoms such as skin rash, reddening, blisters, and the like are possible. In very rare cases, chronic administration of extremely high doses of vitamin B6 can cause nervous lesions (e.g. disturbances of superficial and deep sensory function, unsure gait, disturbance of the tendon reflexes). You must report these side effects to your physician.

If you become pregnant or if you are nursing, you should report this to your physician.

You should inform your physician if you are taking other medications at the same time or if you need to have an operation.

Habituation effects are improbable.

## Attention:

Pronerv capsules contain vitamins of the B group in concentrations which partially exceed 100 times the recommended daily adult dose. For this reason, the medication under no circumstances is appropriate for self-treatment of any symptoms!

Store at room temperature not exceeding 25° C. Protect from light. Keep out of the reach of children!
