HEDERAL®

DESCRIPTION

HEDERAL is the trade name of a natural product (suppositories and alcohol-free cough syrup) developed from the dry leaf extract of Hedera helix (Ivv), and intended for the symptomatic relief of respiratory catarrhs and bronchial conditions. Ivy (Family: Araliaceae) is a plant that grows in Europe, northern and central Asia and the United States.

☐ Each 5 ml of HEDERAL syrup contains 37 mg Hedera helix dry leaf extract.

□Each HEDERAL suppository contains 80 mg Hedera helix dry leaf extract.

COMPOSITION

Hedera helix dry leaf extract is standardized to contain a minimum of 10% hederacoside C.

CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY

Ivy leaf extract is suggested as an expectorant, secretolytic and antispasmodic. Skin and mucosa have been shown to be sensitive to ivy leaf: glycosidic saponins (such as hederacoside C) present in the leaf trigger responses in the gastric mucosa, leading to the activation of bronchial mucous glands and thereby aiding in the removal of mucous secretions. The extract also possesses antibacterial, antimycotic, analgesic and sedative effects.

INDICATIONS

HEDERAL helps relieve symptoms (including cough and phlegm) associated with the following

- Bronchial asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary diseases.
- Catarrhs of the respiratory passages, especially chronic
- Acute and chronic inflammatory bronchial conditions. especially spastic bronchitis.

DOSAGE

Usual adult oral dose:

2-3 teaspoonful (10-15 ml) of HEDERAL syrup, 3 times daily, for at least one week.

Usual pediatric oral dose:

- ☐ Children 1month 4 years old: 1 teaspoonful (5 ml) of HEDERAL syrup, twice daily (morning and evening), for at least
- ☐ Children 4-10 years old: 1.5 teaspoonful (7.5 ml) of HEDERAL syrup, twice daily (morning and evening), for at least one week.
- ☐ Children 10 years old and above: 2 teaspoonful (10 ml) of

HEDERAL syrup, twice daily (morning and evening), for at least one week

Usual pediatric rectal dose:

Children 1year old and above:1HEDERAL suppository, twice daily (morning and evening), for at least one week.

For optimal results, it is recommended to continue using HEDERAL syrup or suppositories for 2-3 days after the symptoms of illness disappear.

ADVERSE EFFECTS

-In rare cases, this product can cause contact dermatitis.

USE IN PREGNANCY AND LACTATION

Due to lack of data, use of the dry leaf extract of Hedera helix should be avoided during pregnancy and lactation.

DRUG INTERACTIONS

None known.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

- Hypersensitivity to any of the components of ivy leaf.
- Pregnancy and lactation.

OVERDOSE

Not documented.

Aphysician should be consulted if symptoms persist.

- □ Bottles of 100ml of HEDERAL syrup (37mg/5ml).
- ☐ Boxes containing 10 HEDERAL 80mg suppositories.

STORAGE CONDITIONS

- ☐ Store according to conditions specified on the package.
- ☐ Keep out of reach of children.
