

Brunicrom 2% eye-drops, solution

Sodium cromoglicate

Composition. 100 ml of solution contain:**Active ingredient:** sodium cromoglicate 2 g.

Excipients: sodium chloride, purified water.

Pharmaceutical form. Eye-drops, solution: 20 single-dose containers of 0.3 ml (6 mg) in thermo-welded envelopes.**Pharmaco-therapeutic category.** Anti-allergic**Marketing authorization holder.** BRUSCHETTINI S.r.l. – Via Isonzo 6 – 16147 Genova (Italy).**Manufacturer.** Laboratoire Unither – Z.I. Longpré – 10 rue André Durouchez 80084 Amiens Cedex 02 (France).**Therapeutic indications.** Preventive treatment of allergic conjunctivitis and of spring kerato-conjunctivitis.**Contra-indications.** Hypersensitivity to the active ingredient.**Precautions for use.** The administration during the first three months of pregnancy must be limited to cases of effective need. **Interactions with other medicaments and other forms of interaction.** Interactions with other pharmaceutical products are not known. In case of treatment with another eye-drops, let pass 15 minutes between the instillations of two different pharmaceutical products**Special warnings.** The absence of preservatives in the formula allows the use of this eye-drops in patients who wear contact lenses.**Effects on ability to drive and use machines.** The product does not interfere either on the ability to drive or to use machineries.**Dosage, method and frequency of administration.**

Instill in the lower conjunctival fornix of each eye, 1 or 2 drops four times a day. Avoid the tip of the single-dose container touches the eye.

Treatment length. When possible, the treatment must be started before exposure to the allergenic stimulus (and then before the symptoms appearance) and it must go on regularly during the whole exposition period or till the symptomatology ends.**Indications for use.**

To use the single dose bottle make the following steps:

- 1) tear a single-dose container off the strip (see fig. A)
- 2) shake the little cap to empty it from the left liquid
- 3) open the single dose bottle by rotating the upper segment and pulling it (see fig. B)
- 4) upturn the container and shake it gently to let the liquid dropping down
- 5) press cautiously the little bottle dropping the prescribed dose into the eye.

N.B. Discard the single dose bottle after use.**Undesirable effects.** The eye-drops instillation can sometimes cause local transient burning and/or itching.

It is advisable that the patient informs the physician or the chemist about whatever side effect not described in this insert.

Expiry. The expiry date is referred to the product in its unopened packaging correctly stored.**Warnings.** Do not use the medicament after the expiry date stamped on its package.

Keep out of the reach and sight of children.

Special precautions for storage. Store in its outer packaging far from light, at a temperature not higher than 25°C
