1. What Reliefast 10 mg, film-coated tablets is and what it is used for Reliefast is a leukotriene receptor antagonist that blocks substances called leukotrienes teukotrienes cause narrowing and swelling of airways in the lungs and also cause allergy symptoms. Certain side effects (such as dizziness and rowsiness) that have been reported very rarely with monteblusts may affect some patients ability to drive or operate machinery.

- 3. How to take Reliefast 10 mg, film-coated tablets

If you take more Reliefast than you should Contact your doctor immediately for advice. There were no side effects reported in the majority of overdose reports. The most frequently occurring symptoms reported with overdose in adults and children included abdominal pain sleepiness, thirst, headache, vomiting, and hyperactivity. If you forget to take Reliefast if you forget to take Reliefasts at prescribed. However, if you miss a dose, just resume the usual schedule of one tablet once daily. Do not take a double dose to make up for a forgotten dose. If you stop taking Reliefast Reliefast and the reliefast your asthma only if you continue to take it. 4. Possible side effects
Like all medicines, Reliefast 10 mg film-coated tablets can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. - abdominal pain\*
- headdache
These were usually mild and occurred at a greater frequency in patients treated with montelukast tablets than placebo (a pill containing no medication).
Additionally, the following side effects have been reported:
- increased bleeding tendency;
- allergic reactions including rash, swelling of the face, lips, tongue, and/or throat which may
