## ALOCLAIR ${ }^{\circ}$

## COMPOSITION

Aloclair contains the film-forming agent polyvinyl pyrrolidone (PVP), purified water, maltodextrin, propylene glycol, Aloe Vera extract, potassium sorbate, sodium benzoate, hydroxyethylcellulose, PEG-40, hydrogenated castor oil, disodium editate, benzalkonium chloride, aroma, saccharin sodium, glycyrrhetinic acid, sodium hyaluronate.

## ACTION

Aloclair is a product for aphthous ulcer, Aloclair contains materials, which forms a thin protective coating in the mouth and so relieves the pain caused by mouth ulcers and other minor traumas such as those caused by dentures and braces.

## INDICATIONS

Aloclair is used to relieve the pain caused by mouth ulcers and other minor traumas, Aloclair with Aloe Vera extract, has a mechanical action which provides pain relief by adhering to the mucosal surface, soothing all types of mouth lesion, aphthous stomatitis, aphthous ulcers, minor lesions, chafing and traumatic ulcers caused by braces and ill-fitting dentures. Aloclair is indicated also for diffused aphthous ulcers.

## DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

- Fill the measuring cap provided to the 5 ml or 10 ml indicator mark.
- Rinse the mouth with the liquid for at least 60 seconds.
- Gargle and spit out.
- Use as needed, up to 3-4 times a day.
- May be used by children who are old enough to follow the instructions.


## CONTRAINDICATION

Aloclair is contraindicated in patients with known history of hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients.

## INTERACTION

There are no known interactions with medicaments or other products. Aloclair may be used during pregnancy and
lactation.

## SIDE EFFECTS

None known.

## OVERDOSAGE

At the time of producing this leaflet no cases of ingestion have been reported.
However, no serious adverse effect should be expected.
