level. level. The recommended starting dose of Renvela tablets for adults and elderly is one to two tablets of 800 mg with each meal, 3 times a day. Check with your doctor, pharmacist or nurse if you are not sure. Take Renvela after your meal or with food. The tablets must be swallowed whole. Do not crush, chew or break into pieces. Initially, your doctor will check the levels of phosphorus in your blood every 2-4 weeks and may adjust the dose of Remvela when necessary to reach an adequate phosphate level.
