Each ampoule contains 1 ml solution of:

Active ingredient: Hyoscine-N-butylbromide 20 mg.

Excipients: Hydrobromic acid and water for injection.

## **Properties**

The active ingredient of Antipan, hyoscine N-butylbromide, is an antimuscarinic agent, having a special site of action at the parasymnaving a special site of action at the paras pathetic ganglia in the walls of the visc Consequently, it exerts a specific antisp modic action on the smooth muscles of gastrointestinal, biliary, and urinary tra the viscera. antispasthe tracts. Being a quaternary ammonium derivative, hyoscine-N-butylbromide does not enter the central nervous system. Therefore, anticholin-ergic side effects at the central nervous system do not occur.

### Indications

Antipan is indicated in the treatment of acute gastrointestinal, biliary and genitourinary spasm including biliary and renal colic. it is indicated as an aid in diagnostic Also. and therapeutic procedures, where spasm may be a problem, e.g. g endoscopy, and in radiology. gastro-duodenal

## Dosage and administration

Adults and children over 6 years: 1-2 ampoules of Antipan (20-40 mg) may be

administered by slow intravenous, intramus-cular or subcutaneous injection several times daily. The maximum daily dose of 100 mg (5 ampoules) should not be exceeded. Antipan should not be taken on a continuous basis or for extended periods without daily

**Antipan** is not recommended for children under 6 years.

### Overdosage

Symptoms: In the case of overdosage, anticholinergic symptoms such as urinary dry mouth, reddening of retention. the skin, rdia, inhibition of gastrointestinal and transient visual disturbances tachycardia, motility, may occur

Therapy: For patients with glaucoma, pilocar-pine should be given locally. Parasympatho-mimetics like neostigmine 0.5-2.5 mg l.M. or I.V. may be given, if necessary.

Antipan is contraindicated in patients known to be hypersensitive to hyoscine-Nbutylbromide. Antipan should not be administered in the

following disorders: glaucoma, hypertrophy of the prostate with urinary retention, mechanical stenosis in the gastrointestinal tract, tachycardia, megacolon and myasthe nia gravis

**Precautions** Caution is recommended when hyoscine butylbromide is given to patients affected by glaucoma, prostatic disorders, mechani prostatic enlargement, cardiac mechanical stenosis in the inal tract, hepatic and renal gastrointestinal testinal tract, hepatic and impairment, and hypertension. unction visual accommodation disturbances occur, patients should not drive or Since occur, may
