#### CASES IN WHICH THIS DRUG CAN BE USED

This medicine is indicated for:

- prevention and treatment of gout attacks,
- familial mediterranean fever,
- Behcet disease,
- Other acute attacks of microcristalline diseases.

#### CAUTION!

#### CASES IN WHICH THIS DRUG MUST NOT BE USED

DO NOT USE this drug in the following cases:

- Severe renal disease,
- Severe hepatic disease.

IF YOU HAVE ANY DOUBT, YOU MUST SEEK ADVICE FROM YOUR PHYSICIAN OR PHARMACIST.

#### SPECIAL WARNINGS

Due to lactose, you should not take this medicine in case of galactosemia, of glucose and galactose malabsorption syndrome, or in case of deficit in lactase (rare metabolic diseases). Due to sucrose, you should not take this medicine in case of fructose intolerance, glucose and galactose malabsorption syndrome, or in case of deficit in sucrase-isomaltase (rare metabolic diseases).

The concomitant intake of colchicine with some antibiotics (see drug interactions) is not recommended.

#### PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

In case of long term treatment, check the blood cells count regularly. In case of hepatic and renal diseases, INFORM YOUR PHYSICIAN.

IF YOU HAVE ANY DOUBT, YOU MUST SEEK ADVICE FROM YOUR PHYSICIAN OR PHARMACIST.

#### DRUG INTERACTIONS AND OTHER INTERACTIONS

This medication should not be associated with some antibiotics (pristinamycin, telithromy azithromycin, clarithromycin, dirithromycin, erythromycin, josamycin, midecamycin, roxitl mycin, troleandomycin except spiramycin).

IN ORDER TO AVOID POSSIBLE INTERACTIONS BETWEEN SEVERAL DRUGS, SYSTEMATICA INFORM YOUR PHYSICIAN OR PHARMACIST OF ANY OTHER CURRENT TREATMENT.

#### **PREGNANCY - LACTATION**

IN CASE OF PREGNANCY OR LACTATION, INFORM YOUR PHYSICIAN.

# HOW TO USE THIS MEDICINE MEDICINE DOSAGE

Acute attacks of gout :

- 1st day: 3 tablets (1 in the morning, 1 in the midday, 1 in the evening),
- 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> days: 2 tablets (1 in the morning and 1 the evening),
- 4th day and following days: 1 tablet in the evening.
- Acute gout attacks prophylaxis: 1 tablet in the evening.
- Other acute attacks of microcristalline diseases, familial mediterranean fever, Beldisease:

1 tablet in the evening.

In any case, strictly comply with your physician's prescription.

## MODE AND ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION Oral route.

**FREQUENCY AND TIME OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE DRUG** This drug should preferably be taken during meals.

#### **ACTION IN CASE OF OVERDOSAGE**

In case of overdosage, REFER IMMEDIATELY TO YOUR PHYSICIAN, AN AN POISONING SPECIALIZED UNIT OR INTENSIVE CARE UNIT, even if the patient statement unchanged.

## ACTION IF ONE OR SEVERAL DOSES HAVE BEEN FORGOTTEN

If a dose has been forgotten, omit the dose and carry on with the scheduled treatme Do not take double dose.

#### **ADVERSE REACTIONS**

LIKE ANY ACTIVE PRODUCT, THIS DRUG CAN CAUSE MORE OR LESS DISTURBI EFFECTS IN SOME SUBJECTS:

- Digestive disorders (diarrhoea, nausea, vomiting), urticaria, skin rash.
- Exceptional blood disorders (cf. Precautions for use).
- Azoospermia (no spermatozoon in the sperm) and neuro-muscular disord reversible after drug discontinuation.

INFORM YOUR PHYSICIAN OR PHARMACIST OF ANY ADVERSE REACTION THIS NOT MENTIONED IN THIS LEAFLET.
