### Efexor XR contains the active substance venlafaxine. Efexor XR is an antidepressant that belongs to a group of medicines

called serotonin and norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors (SNRIs)

This group of medicines is used to treat depression and other conditions such as anxiety disorders. It is not fully understood how antidepressants work, but they may help by increasing the levels of serotonin and norepinephrine in the brain. Efexor XR is a treatment for adults with depression. It is also a treatment for adults with the following anxiety disorders: generalised

anxiety disorder, social anxiety disorder (fear or avoidance of social situations) and panic disorder (panic attacks). Treating depression or anxiety disorders properly is important to help you get better. If it is not treated, your condition may not go away and may become more serious and more difficult to treat. 2. ### If you are allergic to venlafaxine or any of the other ingredients of this medicine (listed in section 6).
